

SmartScreen in Windows is preventing installation of MixMaster

Windows 8, and some versions of Explorer, includes a Smart Screen security feature that inhibits installations of programs unknown to Microsoft.

As MixMaster is not registered with MS, SmartScreen can inhibit its being loaded onto a protected system.

There are two solutions:

1) You can install just MixMaster using this procedure provided by Michael Rideout on the PSR Tutorial Forum:

After you've downloaded a file (program, document, etc.), right-click on the downloaded file and select "Properties."

If the computer automatically mistrusts the file, you'll see a button near the bottom of the first tab screen that says "Unblock." If you trust the file, click the "Unblock" button to let the computer know that you don't want the file to be blocked, then click the "Apply" or "OK" button to complete the action.
